Year 3's Sharing Assembly

This week, Year 3 impressed us all with an engaging sharing assembly. The children spoke confidently and sang with enthusiasm, showing just how much effort they had put into their performance. It was lovely to see such strong teamwork and a reminder of what can be achieved through working together. Our sincere thanks go to Ms Cooper for preparing the children so thoroughly, and to Mrs Parker for her invaluable support, including creating such wonderful props, which helped make the performance so memorable.

PFE Challenge

The PFE Challenge kicks off on Monday! This fun, voluntary sponsored event gives children the chance to get creative while helping the school. Funds raised will support both everyday needs and bigger projects this year, including new phonics readers for the early years and air conditioning. Children can choose any activity to earn sponsorship — from walking, cycling, or running, to reading or other imaginative ideas — ideally something that boosts their wellbeing during Wellbeing Week. The suggested target is £26 per child, but every contribution counts. Sponsorship can be collected in cash or online via class-specific links, and the class that raises the most will win £100 towards new class games. 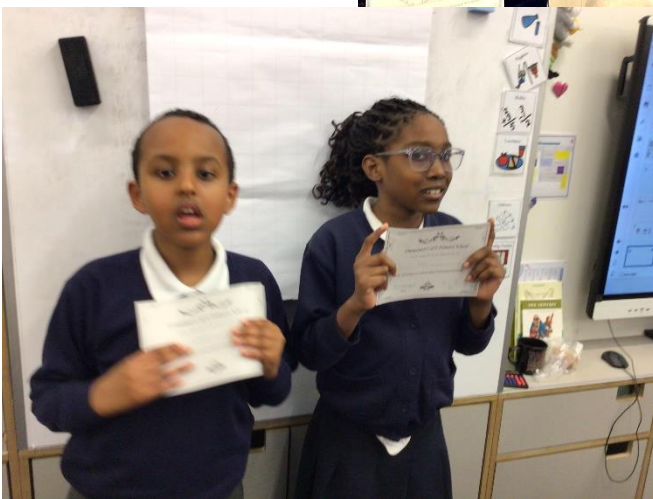

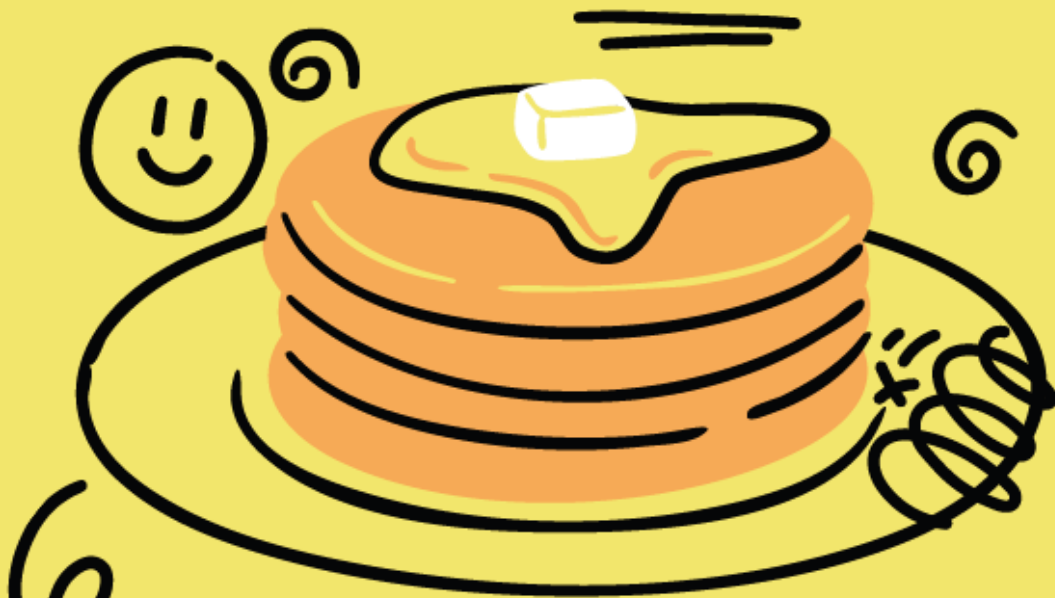

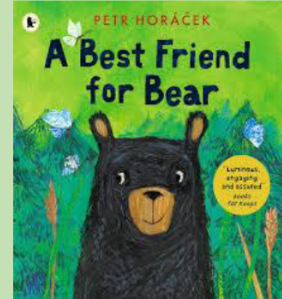
