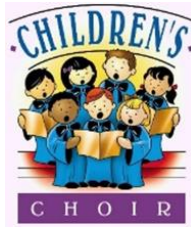

Dear parents and carers,

Choir for Years 4-6 will be recommencing every Tuesday from **Tuesday 14th April** until (and including) **Tuesday 7th July 2026**. It will be run by Miss Taylor.

This club is for Years 4-6 children only. There are only 30 places which will be allocated on a first come first served basis. Children are not automatically entitled to a place because they may have attended the club previously. **The cost per session is £7, £84 for 12 sessions.**

The club will run on Tuesday afternoons from **3.30pm-4.30pm**. Children must be collected from the MUGA at 4.30pm promptly. It is not possible for children to be walked up to Fortune Green Playcentre after the club.

To sign up for the club, please visit <https://login.arbor.sc/> or open your Arbor app. You will need to log in with the information that is requested on the front page. The booking facility will be open from **8.00pm on Sunday 15th March** and will close at **12.00pm on Wednesday 18th March 2026**. In order to secure a place you will need to make payment within Arbor, at which point you will automatically be added to the club list and it will be visible within your child's profile. When a club is full, there will no longer be the facility to book or make payment for it.

If you would prefer to pay for your club via HMRC Tax Free Childcare or with Childcare Vouchers, please register for the club but do not make payment. Instead, make payment to the school through your chosen scheme or provider and email us on clubs@emmanuel.camden.sch.uk to let us know what to expect.
