Celebrating Diversity Week

We were delighted to celebrate **Diversity Week** across the school, with pupils taking part in a wide range of engaging activities that encouraged them to learn about, appreciate and celebrate the diversity within our school, our local community and the wider world.

Throughout the week, each class explored a range of themes including different cultures, faiths, family structures, abilities and life experiences through stories, discussions, art, music and creative activities. Pupils reflected on the importance of kindness, respect and inclusion, making meaningful links to our Christian vision and values. It was wonderful to see thoughtful conversations taking place as children celebrated both our similarities and our differences.

We were incredibly proud of the enthusiasm, curiosity and respect shown by all our children throughout the week. Diversity Week provided a valuable opportunity to reinforce that every person is unique, every family is valued, and everyone belongs within our school community.
