A new language journey at Emmanuel

We are excited to share that, from next academic year, we will be changing our language provision from Latin to Spanish. As part of our ongoing curriculum development and in response to the changing expectations around

primary languages education, we have carefully reviewed how we can best provide our children with a language experience that is engaging, accessible and prepares them for the future.

Latin has been a valuable part of our curriculum and has supported children in developing their understanding of vocabulary, word origins and the structure of language. However, as schools continue to review their curriculum offer, there is an increasing focus on children developing confidence in speaking and listening in a modern foreign language. We have therefore made the decision to move towards Spanish, giving pupils greater opportunities to communicate in a language that is widely spoken around the world and to develop their understanding of different cultures and communities.

We are delighted that Miss Styllis will continue to lead the teaching of languages at Emmanuel. Spanish is her specialism, and she is looking forward to sharing her knowledge, enthusiasm and expertise with the children.

We are also aware that some of our pupils already speak Spanish at home, and we want to reassure families that these children will be fully supported and challenged. Lessons will include opportunities for children with existing Spanish knowledge to extend their vocabulary, develop their grammar, improve their written skills and deepen their understanding of the language.

We are excited to begin this new chapter and look forward to seeing our children become confident, enthusiastic and curious Spanish learners.

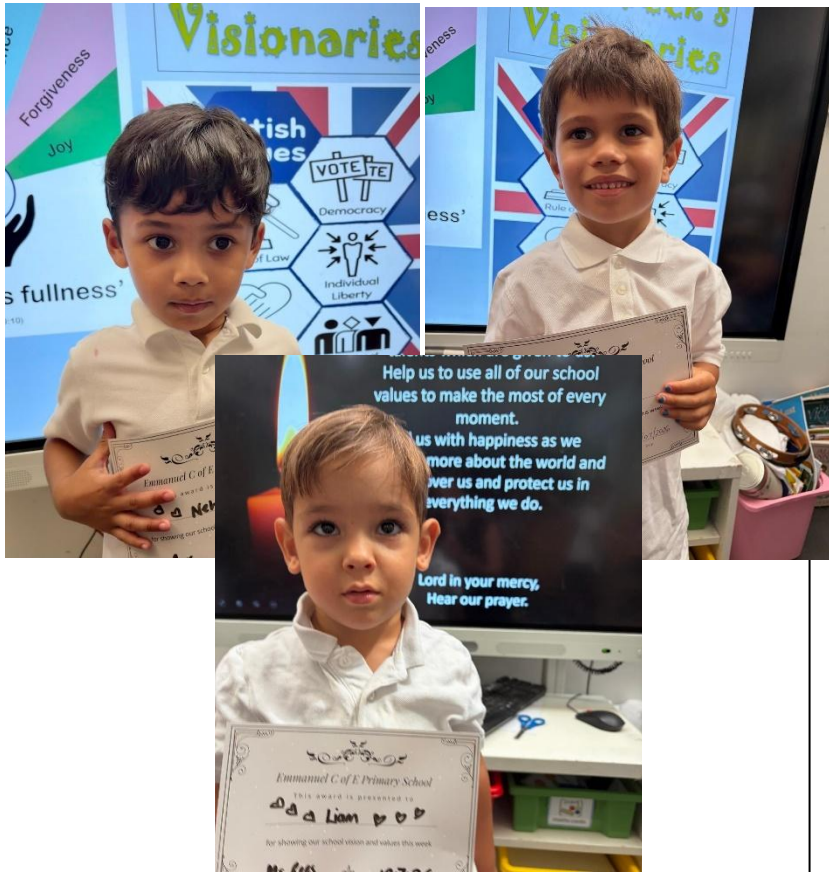

CELEBRATION OF MAKERS 2026

Hands-on Crafts, Heritage & Creative Engagement

27 - 30 August 2026, Two Temple Place, WC2R 3BD

In August 2026, Two Temple Place and the City & Guilds of London Art School will return with the free Celebration of Makers, following the success of 2025, which welcomed over 2,700 visitors. Attendees enjoyed hands-on experiences in wood and stone carving, gilding, conservation, stained glass, and more, alongside an independent makers' market and family workshops.

This unique partnership celebrates heritage craftsmanship at Two Temple Place while giving the public — especially those not usually exposed to craft — a chance to try, explore, and engage with making. It's also a valuable platform for young craftspeople to demonstrate their skills, explain their methods, and gain public speaking experience.

The event forms part of 2TP's wider community programme, including workshops, talks, and market opportunities. In 2025, all community slots filled quickly, evening talks explored topics from marble inlay to 3-D printing in carving, and drop-in workshops drew hundreds of participants.
