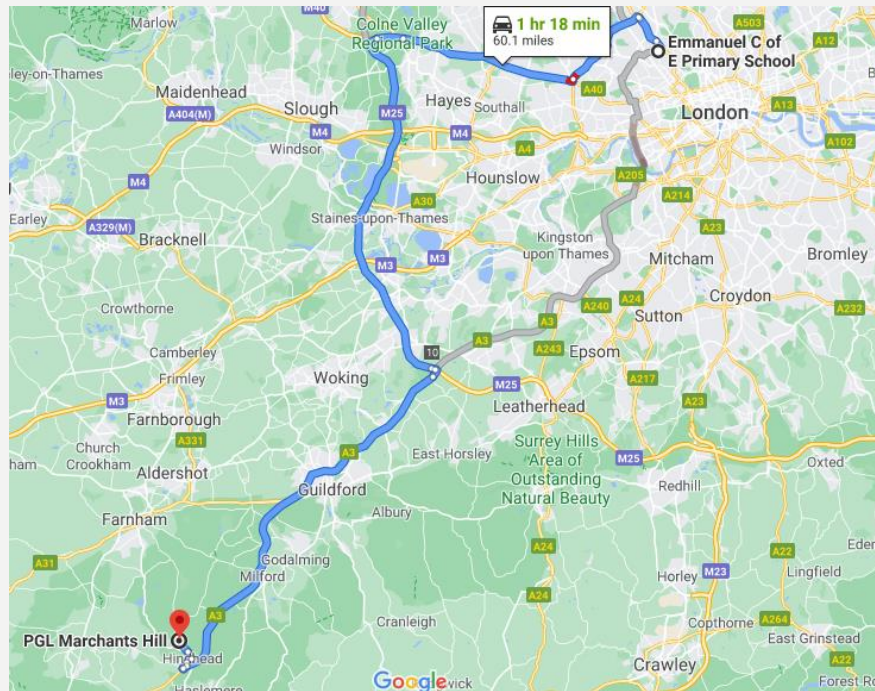


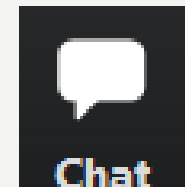

Schedule	Activities
07.00 - 09.00	Get up, get ready and fuel up for the day ahead
09.15 - 12.30	Morning activities - usually 2 sessions with a 15 minute break in-between
12.30 - 14.00	Dry off & clean up. Time for a fresh & tasty two-course hot lunch
14.15 - 17.30	Afternoon activities - 2 exciting sessions with a 15 minute break in-between
18.00 - 19.00	Time to eat again - a different menu each day
19.00 - 21.00	Talent shows, campfires, quizzes and more. The evening entertainment programme keeps you laughing until bedtime.
21.00 / 21.30	Bedtime. Catch up on some zzz's and prepare to do it all over again tomorrow!

ACCOMMODATION

- Girls and boys are in separate bedrooms.
- The rooms have bunk beds for 4 or 6 pupils and there is an en-suite bathroom.
- Teachers' rooms are at the end each of block, and within the row.
- We will ask the children with whom they would like to share a room and we will try to accommodate their requests.
- Children will need to bring a sleeping bag and a pillow as quilts are not provided.
- Regular room checks, by both male and female Emmanuel staff.



STAYING IN CONTACT

- There will be at least one message every day.
- Photos will be shared.
- Children will **not** be allowed to bring mobile phones (or other electronics e.g. iPads). Playing cards, books and small games instead.
- If your child is unwell and needs to be collected from the centre, we will contact you.



PAYMENT

- The cost of the trip is £400
- Subsidy requests to the school office by Friday 13th November
- The deadline for payment is Friday 19th March— either one payment or the cost can be spread over the 3 months.
- Payments online using Scopay
- This information will be followed up with a letter



WHAT'S NEXT

- Await the follow-up letter with all the details for the trip
- Fill in your permission slip on Parenthub
- Organise your payment for the trip – Ask the office / Mr Edwards for a subsidy request if needed
- Plan a sleepover, particularly if your child has not had one before.
- A further meeting in March (kit lists, medical information, keeping in contact)
