

Pangolin facts by Anthony, 3P

What's scaly from tip to tail and curls into a ball? Pangolins!

These nocturnal mammals are easily recognised by their amour of scales. If a pangolin is threatened it will roll up into a ball while the tail can be used to defend.

There are 8 types of pangolins over two continents. They range from vulnerable to critically endangered. 4 species live in Africa including black-bellied, giant ground and Temminick's ground pangolin.

Artemis mission



SLS in a testing phase

NASA (the National Aeronautics and Space Administration) will attempt to bring humans to the moon through a programme called Artemis. The programme will start with a launch into Earth's orbit to test the systems in August of 2022. Then Artemis 2 is where a deep space flyby of the moon will be performed and this will commence in May of 2024. The Artemis program's third mission, the first lunar landing in over 50 years, is scheduled to commence in October of 2024. This will be where two astronauts will perform a series of spacewalks on the moon.

To achieve such a goal, NASA has acquired multiple spacecraft for performing different tasks throughout the missions. SLS stands for Space Launch System and is the largest rocket ever developed. Orion is the crew capsule and will transport the crew from the rocket to Gateway

Gateway is the lunar space station that will act as a platform to transfer from the Orion spacecraft to the HLS. HLS stands for Human Landing System and is the spaceship that will land humans on the moon.

The teams that worked on this project are Airbus, ESA (European Space Agency), Spacex, Boeing, Lockheed Martin and NASA.







This is optional but I cut a circle out of my excess paper and glued it on top.




Now time to decorate! You can use pens pencils paint gems sequins and so on to give this regal crown some colour.
