



Baking corner

BLUEBERRY MAXI MUFFINS by Georgia, 4R

YOU WILL NEED:

200g of plain flour 3 tbsp. oil (vegetable or sunflower)

200g of desiccated coconut 250ml of milk 75g of golden caster sugar 100g of blueberries

3 tsp of baking powder a 12-hole muffin tin and cases

2 mashed ripe bananas a large cooking bowl 2 beaten eggs a wooden spoon

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Preheat the oven to 200c (400f / gas mark 6) and pop the muffin cases in the tin.


2. In a big bowl, mix the desiccated coconut, flour, sugar and baking powder.

3. Make a well in the centre and add the bananas, eggs, oil and milk. Mix it together until it's nice and sloppy.

4. Stir in the blueberries.

5. Pour into the muffin cases and bake for 20 minutes. They should be puffy and golden on top.

6. Cool on a rack. ENJOY!



GEORGIA'S BANANA BREAD

YOU WILL NEED:

115g butter a pinch of salt

115g light brown sugar a 2lb (23cm x 13cm) loaf tin

Two beaten eggs greaseproof paper or a loaf Tin liner

Four mashed ripe bananas

(The squidgier the better) a large cooking bowl 250g of plain flour a wooden spoon

1 tsp of bicarbonate of soda a metal skewer


INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Preheat the oven to 180c (350f/gas mark 4) and line the loaf tin.
- 2. In a large bowl, cream together the butter and sugar.
- 3. Add the eggs and bananas (the mixture will be quite sloppy by now).
- 4. Stir in the flour, salt and bicarbonate of soda. Do not worry if it looks a bit lumpy!
- 5. Pour into the loaf tin and bake for one hour.
- 6. Check it is cooked by sticking a skewer into the middle of the loaf. It should come out mostly clean. If there is sloppy mixture stuck to it, the bread is not done yet so give it another 5 minutes and check again.
- 7. When the skewer comes out clean, remove the loaf from the oven and leave it to cool in the tin for 15 minutes, and then turn out onto a rack. ENJOY!

At the time, in the 1960s and 80s, Search and rescue was a key thing that only planes with pontoons (floats) could land on water. The only helicopters at the time were Sikorsky H-19, H-34, R-4 and the Bristol Sycamore. Both of these fit the solution of the role. Both were licensed built Sikorsky helicopters, on the Wessex it had a radar more expensive than the helicopter itself. The Whirlwind was a slow aircraft for its time and was ideal for holding steady over the water. AS they are old aircraft there are not many operational ones left although Historic Helicopters have a few left.
