Windrush Day

2023 sees the 75th anniversary of the HMT Empire Windrush arriving in Britain on 22nd June 1948. Windrush Day has become a key symbolic moment in the story of the Black British contribution to this country and the broader post-war migration from across the Commonwealth and beyond that has helped create the modern Britain that we share today. At Emmanuel, we will be marking this important event by talking to children about the history of Windrush, the stories of the people that arrived and how this has affected both their lives and the wider impact it has had on the United Kingdom. Free school meals

Please do check to see if your child/ren is/are eligible for free school meals and apply today at <u>camden.gov.uk/free-school-meals</u> - it could save you over £500 a year and will give them access to extra support too. If your child is eligible but you prefer to make them a packed lunch, please still sign them up because our school will receive vital funding. This will remain important next academic year when all primary school children are due to receive free school meals funded by the Mayor of London.

Secondary transition event

Parents of pupils in Years 4, 5 and 6 are invited to the <u>Camden Moving On to Secondary School Event</u>, which is being held at the <u>Francis Crick Institute</u>, in King's Cross, on Thursday, 21 September, with staggered entry times between 4.15pm and 6.45pm. <u>Register to attend here</u>. Polio/MMR Campaign

In response to the findings of the polio virus in sewage in London boroughs last summer, the Joint Committee on Vaccination and Immunisation (JCVI), has advised that all children should be up-to-date with the polio vaccine. Measles cases are also increasing in London and children should be up-to-date with completion of 2 doses of MMR vaccine. The NHS in London is therefore offering polio vaccinations and measles, mumps and rubella (MMR) to unvaccinated or partially-vaccinated children aged 1 to 11. The NHS School Aged Immunisation Team will be contacting the parents of children who are not fully vaccinated to discuss whether your child will be offered a school-based vaccination or a clinic appointment.
