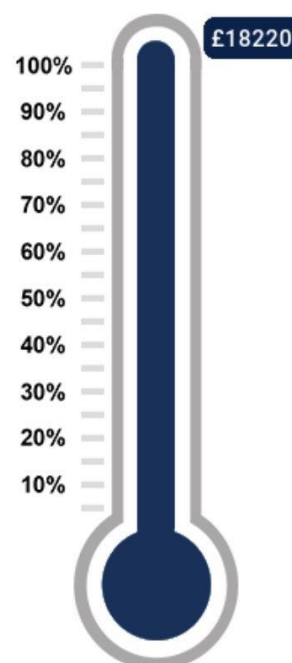
# PFE HAPPENINGS
