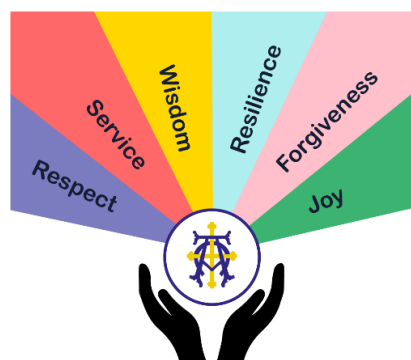

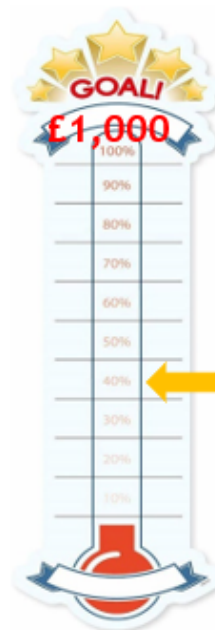




Update from the School Council
