Extending our wellbeing and mental health provision

This year, Emmanuel has established a link with the Mental Health Support Team (MHST) based at the Tavistock to help further develop and support the school's wellbeing provision for pupils, parents/carers and staff. Victoria O'Mard will be our new MHST Practitioner and she will be at Emmanuel each week either providing one-to-one wellbeing interventions with children or parents, or providing whole-class interventions. - Sibling rivalry

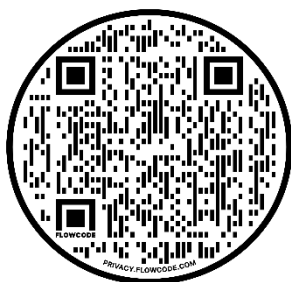
Webinars for Parents/Carers of Primary aged children

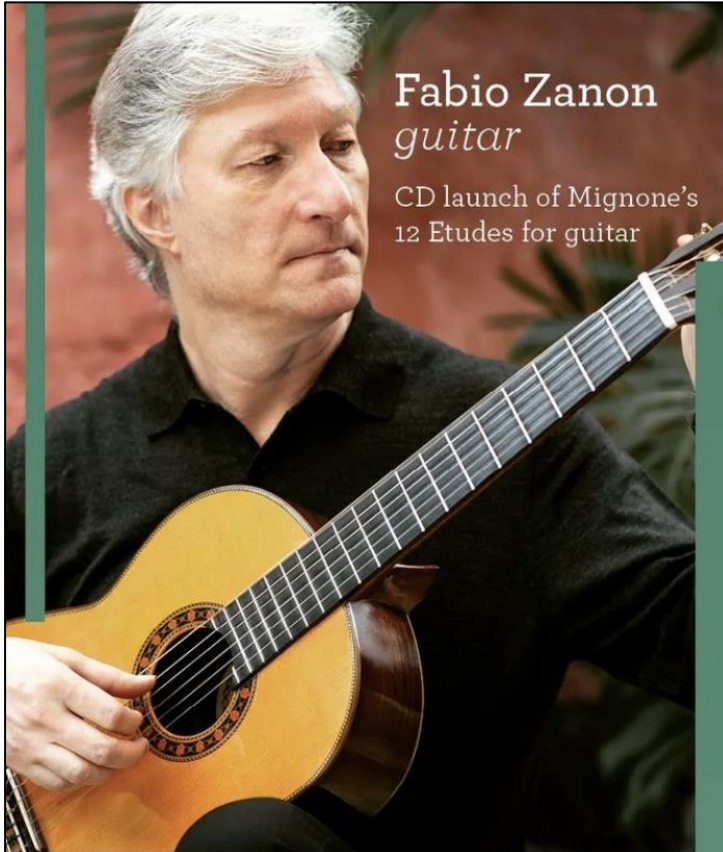

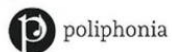
