### **Year 6 Sharing Assembly**

Year 6 presented a very moving and energetic assembly about World War 2. They had clearly learned a lot about the topic, and it was great to see them immersed in such an important but complex part of history. Thank you to all the parents who came to support them, and to Ms Adams and Mrs Watkins for directing an excellent performance.

### **Crick Workshops**

On Thursday, all the children had a chance to become scientists for the day as we were lucky to have visitors from the Francis Crick Institute in London visiting us. Year 1 used their senses to identify mystery objects, Year 2 learnt about the journey of germs, Year 3 investigated the jobs of the skeleton and muscles in our body, Year 4 learnt all about vibrations and how our hearing works and Year 6 explored how light travels and reflects.

Year 5 spent the day visiting the Francis Crick Institute and took part in investigations around electricity, and the properties of materials.

The atmosphere around school was electric and all the children loved finding out new facts about the world around us.

### **Natural History Museum**

I was lucky enough to accompany Reception class on their trip to the Natural History Museum, and their knowledge about dinosaurs and enthusiasm for the topic was palpable! Thank you to Miss Turley, Ms Gurik, Mrs Parker and Mr Zeoli for all their efforts, and to all the parent helpers who accompanied us.
