Definition: Living life God's way

Forgiveness cannot be given or received unless it is asked for, and the asking must be genuine and from the heart. Too often 'sorry' is said very easily, implying: 'All I need to do is say I'm sorry and everything will be OK'. **Real repentance demands that we take what we have done wrong with the utmost seriousness and have a deep desire not to do it again.** Jesus was uncompromising in his command to forgive. Forgive, he said, 'seventy times seven' (Matthew 18:21). In other words, forgive and keep on forgiving without limit.

Questions

When did I last say sorry? Whom do I need to forgive? Why is it hard to forgive? What does it feel like to be forgiven? How do I know I am forgiven? How many times must I forgive someone? Is it really possible to forgive and forget? Is there a limit to forgiveness?

Colours of the Liturgical Calendar –

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<p>Purple: Penance and Preparation</p> 	<p>Red: Sacrifice, the Holy Spirit</p> 	<p>Green: Hope, Life and Growth</p> 	<p>Gold: Joy and Celebration</p> 	<p>White: Purity</p> 	<p>No colour: Desolation</p> 
<p>Purple is used for times of deep thinking and reflection. It is also sometimes used at adult funerals.</p>	<p>Red is used for saints' days who have died as martyrs and represents the flame of the Holy Spirit.</p>	<p>Green is used to represent quiet growth during the time between festivals and seasons.</p>	<p>Gold used for special occasions.</p>	<p>White represents purity. It often represents a season of celebration rather than a day.</p>	<p>On these two days of the year, the church is stripped bare of all decoration and flowers.</p>
<p>Used during Advent and Lent</p>	<p>Pentecost/Whitsun Martyr's saints' days</p>	<p>Used throughout Ordinary Time.</p>	<p>Special days of celebration e.g. Easter Day and Christmas</p>	<p>Used in the seasons of Easter and Christmas and for saints who were not martyred.</p>	<p>Good Friday and Holy Saturday</p>
