

The Royal family by Amelia B, 6W





Where: muga


Unlimited or limited players: Unlimited Things you need to use for the game: a ball


Rules

How to play

At the start, one person (the questioner) goes in the middle of the circle and asks a question about a specific topic to the rest of the people in the circle. The questioner has a ball and throws it to a random person in the circle. If that person who gets the ball does not catch it, they are still safe. Once you catch the ball, the questioner asks you a question and you answer it. If you get the question wrong you have 10 seconds to run and hide. The rest of the people come and find you. When they find and tag you, you sit down in the circle and be out. If you get it right, you can get someone who was out before back in. You are safe too. You change the questioner after each round.


Maths tricks

Think of a whole number below 10. Double it. Add 6. Halve it. Subtract your original number. Your answer is 3.




Ideas for half term if you get bored! By Leigh and Lara, Y5
