# School Council Fundraiser

#### Dear parents and carers

The School Council have organised this new fundraiser to raise money for Great Ormond Street Hospital (75%) and for new golden time games for each classroom (25%). We would like our pupils to ask family and friends to sponsor them to get active by completing at least one kilometer on every day in May. This can be running, walking, scooting, swimming or cycling. This can be jogging on the spot too.

#### How far is 1 kilometer in terms of physical activity?

Don't worry if you haven't got a tracker, you can use these times as a guide to how far one kilometer is.

- 12 laps of the outside of the MUGA
- 6 minutes of running, scooting or cycling
- 13 minutes of walking
- 9 minutes of fast walking
- 40 lengths of Swiss Cottage swimming pool
- They can do this on the spot too if you can't go outside.



The children will try to do this in school when possible but we would really like them to record when they do this during after school clubs, walking to or from school, walking to PACE or activities over the weekend.

For children in Reception class: we are only expecting them to do 1km a day if they can, it's taking part that counts!
