Emmanuel is presented the 'Wellbeing Award for Schools' accreditation

We are delighted to confirm that Emmanuel has been awarded for its positive whole-school approach to Mental Health and Wellbeing. The verifier spent the day with us, looking through evidence and examples of what we do, talking to parents, pupils, staff and our link Governor, to understand in detail how we integrate this crucial area in all aspects of school life and the learning of our children. Here are some of the lovely comments that he wrote in his report:

- *'Children I spoke with were confident and thoughtful and had lots of suggestions and strategies for supporting their own or others' EWMH. They know where to get help when they need it and can describe how they discuss feelings and emotions in lessons.'*



PFE

The school is looking for a new Parents and Friends of Emmanuel (PFE) committee. The PFE needs a new chair, secretary, treasurer and communications officer for the 2024/25 school year. These four roles very much work together as a team and previous holders of the posts have found them to be incredibly rewarding. They are vitally important to the school, not only from a fundraising perspective but also in nurturing and developing our Emmanuel community. There is also the small matter of the fact that the PFE a registered charity; legally, it must have a committee, without which it must be dissolved!

Responsibilities include organising the Christmas and Summer fairs, managing the Regular Giving Program and driving other smaller events and activities. However, this is not done in isolation. There is a substantial cohort of volunteers on hand to help achieve this, as well as a lot of support from the school itself. The outgoing committee will also be on hand to support as much as they can, and provide a comprehensive handover.

The school have worked really hard with the PFE in recent years to build a strong framework that takes the pressure off successive committees and makes running the PFE as simple as possible. There is no 'right way' to do it. All of the infrastructure and processes are very much in place, all we need now are some fresh faces to put their stamp on the roles and do it their way 😊

Dear Parents and Carers,

Camden Mental Health Support Team (MHST) are excited to be offering a **2-part, face-to-face workshop** for parents and carers of primary age children (4-11 years) on:

Tuesday 25th June 12:15-14:30 at the Tavistock Centre

and

Tuesday 2nd July 12:15-14:30 at the Tavistock Centre

The workshop will explore Emotion Coaching, a parenting approach that supports identifying and validating emotions, while also setting boundaries and limits around behaviour.

How will Emotion Coaching help you and your child?

- To better understand and validate your child's emotions
- To respond more helpfully during moments of heightened emotion
- To implement appropriate boundary setting
- To reduce behaviours that you find challenging
- To further improve the parent/child relationship
- To learn from other parents and carers

This is an interactive workshop, which will involve sharing research, learning about Emotion Coaching and practising strategies. We often find that group workshops are a great space to learn from each other so there will be lots of opportunities to talk about ideas and to think through any challenges that might be around.
