Dear parents and carers,

We've had another jam-packed week with trips, auditions, workshops and more! Diversity Week and Express Yourself 'dress up' day on Wednesday

Next week, all our children will be celebrating Diversity Week in their classes and Collective Worship. In a special PSHE lesson and circle time stories they will be talking about all the ways we are different - things we can see and things we can't see - such as what we look like, our voices, our culture and heritage, gender, strengths and talents and our families. In particular, we will be celebrating how, just like as an Emmanuel family, we are all different and we all have different types of families. On Tuesday we will be championing our individual strengths and talents with the final of Emanuel's Got Talent. On Wednesday we will be hosting a dress up day called 'Express Yourself' where we would like to encourage the children to express who they are through their clothes, hair etc. Pupils could wear their favourite colour or choose a range of colours that express who they are and what they like, how they are different to others. Colour can be very personal and mean different things to different people, so this is a great opportunity to encourage self-expression. Alternatively, they could dress up in the things that they enjoy e.g. their favourite hobbies or interests. Dear Parents and Carers,

Camden Mental Health Support Team (MHST) are excited to be offering a **2-part, face-to-face workshop** for parents and carers of primary age children (4-11 years) on:

Tuesday 25th June 12:15-14:30 at the Tavistock Centre

and

Tuesday 2nd July 12:15-14:30 at the Tavistock Centre

The workshop will explore Emotion Coaching, a parenting approach that supports identifying and validating emotions, while also setting boundaries and limits around behaviour.

How will Emotion Coaching help you and your child?

- To better understand and validate your child's emotions
- To respond more helpfully during moments of heightened emotion
- To implement appropriate boundary setting
- To reduce behaviours that you find challenging
- To further improve the parent/child relationship
- To learn from other parents and carers

This is an interactive workshop, which will involve sharing research, learning about Emotion Coaching and practising strategies. We often find that group workshops are a great space to learn from each other so there will be lots of opportunities to talk about ideas and to think through any challenges that might be around.
