Reading-

At Level 4+, Y6 PP attainment (100%) was above national PP attainment (83%) and above national attainment percentages for all pupils (89%). The gap between pupil premium attainment and national pupil attainment was closed.

At Level 5, Y6 PP attainment (75%) was above national PP attainment (34%) and above national attainment percentages for all pupils (48%). The attainment of level 5 PP was significantly above national PP attainment and national attainment for all pupils.

Writing-

At Level 4+, Y6 PP attainment (100%) was above national PP attainment (79%) and above national attainment percentages for all pupils (87%). The gap between pupil premium attainment and national pupil attainment was closed.

At L5+, Y6 PP attainment (50%) was above national PP attainment (22%) and above national attainment percentages for all pupils (36%).

Maths-

At Level 4+, Y6 PP attainment (100%) was above PP national attainment (80%) and above national attainment percentages for all pupils (87%). The gap between pupil premium attainment and national pupil attainment was closed.

At Level 5+, PP attainment (50%) was above PP national attainment (28%) and above national attainment percentages for all pupils (41%). The gap between pupil premium attainment and national pupil attainment was closed.

What was the impact on the progress of Pupil Premium children in Y6?

Green indicates that given their starting point at the end of KS1, Pupil Premium pupils at Emmanuel School made better progress than all pupils nationally.
