Jewels School Update

Emmanuel School continues to have links with Jewels Primary School in Freetown, Sierra Leone. After being forced to close for over a year due to the Ebola crisis, the school, based on the outskirts of the capital city, officially reopened on 11th January 2016.



Last year, Emmanuel School provided vital support to help Jewels reopen; through donating money which was used to purchase both thermometers and bricks so that a partition wall was built at the end of the playground and the children's temperature was regularly checked to ensure the safety of each pupil.

Georgiana Karbo, the inspirational founder and proprietor of the school, has always wanted to provide children with an education past primary school. The majority of Year 6 children from Jewels, do not go onto a secondary school due to cost and travel distance. Georgiana has begun to build a block of secondary classrooms to extend Jewel School and to provide children with access to education past the age of 11.



The PFE have generously agreed that half the proceeds from this year's International Evening will go towards purchasing building materials to support more children in Allen Town to have access to education. Please take a look at the photos the building work so far.
