### Key Stage 2 Trip to Broadstairs Beach

Due to the generosity of the PFE who are funding this trip, we will be taking children in years 3 – 6 to the Seaside (Broadstairs) on Monday 18th July. We will be travelling by coach, leaving at 9am and returning to school at approximately 4.30pm.

#### Packed Lunch

Your child will need to bring a suitable packed lunch, snacks and water (no glass bottles/fizzy drinks please) for the whole day.

#### Clothing

Please keep an eye on the weather as we near the date and provide suitable clothing as appropriate. As many children may want to paddle in the sea, it is a very good idea for them to wear bathing costumes underneath their clothing (no uniform that day).

It is also advisable to pack a towel and change of clothes so that children can change into dry clothes for the return journey.

#### Other

If sun lotion is needed, it must be applied by parents in the morning (and self-administered by the children during the day). Similarly, travel sickness tablets should be administered by parents in the morning – please speak to your child's teacher regarding travel sickness tablets for the return journey.

#### Parent Volunteers

We will need parent volunteers to support the children on the journey and on the beach. We anticipate that we will be inundated with requests to volunteer. Therefore, we are sure that you will understand if you have been unfortunate in securing a place.

However you will be more than welcome to join us at the beach in Broadstairs, having made your own way there. You can travel from Victoria to Broadstairs on the train. You can obtain details at <http://www.nationalrail.co.uk>.

Parents who volunteer must be aware that they are needed to support a group of children at all times. You will be responsible for a group and not just your own child and you will need to be able to go into the sea to form a 'human chain' to enable the children to paddle safely!
