

The deadline is midnight on Tuesday 31st
October 2017





How do I apply?

Late applications will not be considered until after the first round of offers. If there is a good reason for a late application, it may be treated as on-time.

You must let the Admissions Team know your reason by Friday 8th December 2017.



How do I apply?



- You can apply for up to six schools and rank the schools in your order of preference. Think carefully about the order as you will not be able to change it after the closing date
- You can apply to schools outside Camden. Include all your chosen schools on the same application form.



Be realistic!



- If you just apply for one school, it will not increase your chances of getting a place at the school and your child will be considered for that one school only
- If this is unsuccessful, you may miss out on an offer which could have been made at another school and you are likely to be offered a place at the nearest school with a vacancy
- It is important to make realistic school choices to increase your chances of securing a offer and avoid disappointment



What happens next?



Co-ordinated admissions

- all 33 London boroughs and surrounding county councils are included in the co-ordinated admissions process
- application lists are exchanged
- offer lists are drawn up
- offer lists are exchanged





What happens next?

If your child can be offered more than one school, you will be offered the school which you ranked higher

The lower preference schools will be withdrawn and offered to other children

No child will be offered more than one school place

What happens next?



- National Offer Day is Thursday 1 March 2018.
- Results will be available in the evening of 1st March.
- You must login to your online account to view the outcome of your application
- Places to be accepted or declined online by 15th March 2018



No offer?

If you don't receive a place at any of your preference schools, your child will be allocated a place at the nearest school with a vacancy.

- Remain on the waiting lists
- Appeal for a place
- Join waiting lists for other schools



Appeals

- Every parent has the right of appeal, which are heard by an independent panel. You will have the opportunity to present your case in person
- You will need to convince the panel that your child's needs are more important than the school's need to limit the admission number
- Appeals are unlikely to be successful unless there are exceptional grounds
