



### Reception 2018 Intake Data

On the day the Admissions Committee sat there were 202 applications. Forty-one (41) applications were received under criteria A and one hundred and sixty-one (161) applications through criteria B. The net capacity for Reception at that time was 30 places. Two-thirds of places were allocated under Route A -twenty (20) and one third of places under Route B – ten (10) (see admissions criteria).

Late applications were received subsequent to the first round of offers being made.

The following table clarifies the number of places that were allocated based on each admissions criterion. (Please note the information in the tables below are a *summary* of the policy criteria and footnotes and further details are contained in the full admission policy).
