KS2 Netball Club will recommence on **Monday 14 January 2019 at 8.00am**. It will run every Monday morning until (and including) **Monday 25 March**.

This club is for KS2 Children only (children who will be in Years 3 – 6). **There are only 16 places with eight spaces being reserved for boys and eight for girls. These places will be allocated on a first come first served basis.** Please ensure that you select the correct registration option when you sign up online!

The club runs from 8.00am - 8.40am. Children will need to come to school in their sportswear and appropriate footwear. They should bring their school uniform to change into. We kindly ask that you provide your child with a bottle of water. **Children are to meet at the back gate** – they do not need to come through the school.

To sign up for the club, please visit <https://emmanuelce.parentseveningsystem.co.uk>. You will need to log in with the information that is requested on the front page. The booking facility will be open from **6.00pm on Thursday, 22 November**. The closing date for registration is **6.00pm on Tuesday, 4 December** but popular clubs are likely to fill up before then.

The cost of the club for this term is £25 (£2.50 per session). Please do not send in any money at this stage. If your child is allocated a place we will notify you and you should make full payment by return otherwise we will offer the place to the next child on the waiting list. We do expect children to stick to clubs; therefore, this subscription fee is non-refundable.

Extended school activities are run for the benefit and enjoyment of all children, therefore, any child who regularly does not comply with the teacher will be asked to leave the club.

In the event of regular non-attendance, the place may be given to someone else.

If all the spaces have been allocated, your child will be put on a waiting list for the spring term. Please remember, this will not give your child priority for the following term.
