**Summer 1 and summer 2 2019**  
**Topic: Crime and Punishment/Eastern Europe**



**LITERACY**

**On-going:** Spelling, Handwriting, Guided Reading.

Children should read for at least 20 minutes each night. During Guided Reading the children will be reading a range of high quality short-stories to develop their comprehension skills. This term will be focusing on the works of William Shakespeare. We will begin by reading Shakespeare's Sonnet 18 and identify the conventions of these poems. Later in the term, the children will be studying in depth Shakespeare's Macbeth. They will be creating a range of different text types based on the characters, setting and plot of the play. We will then move onto reading Romeo and Juliet and exploring the text through drama to understand the key themes and characters.

**Spelling:** We will begin to learn spellings from the Y5/6 and the words from the list.

**NUMERACY** - This term we will be focusing on consolidating understanding of place value and applying that knowledge to the four main operations (addition, subtraction, multiplication and division). Additionally we will be studying aspects of geometry (rotation, translation and reflection) and finding fractions and percentages of numbers.

**P.E** - This term children will have PE on a **Thursday** morning with Mr Spadaccini and will have swimming on a Tuesday afternoon. Please ensure children have their PE kits in school at all times.

**Music** The children will be taught music by Mr Pegdon this year and will also continue learning a brass instrument.

**SCIENCE -**

**Earth and Space** - This half-term we will be studying astronomy and exploring our planets and the solar system. We will be looking at the Earth, Sun, Moon and planets and their position and movements around the solar system. We will be exploring the Earth's orbit and its effect on how long our years are compared to other planets. We will then move onto looking at how the Earth spins on its axis and the implications days, times and seasons for different countries around the world.

**Geography, summer 2: Eastern Europe**

In the second half term we will be exploring the geographical regions of Eastern Europe. Within this, we will be learning about the different countries and cities within Eastern Europe, the range of landscapes that cover the region, the tourist attractions and famous monuments and compare the climates of different regions within the continent. We will finish the topic by looking at the Chernobyl nuclear disasters and its after-effects.

**History, Summer 1 - Crime and punishment** - We will be studying the social history of crime and punishment from the Roman justice system through the Anglo-Saxon, Tudor and Victorian periods. We will deepen our historical awareness and understanding of how our past is constructed and reflect and evaluate the legacies of past judicial systems and their influence on our system today.

**PSHE** - This term in PSHE we will be looking at our emotions and how to understand and control them. We will also be looking at how to stay safe online and what is appropriate and inappropriate to post online.

**R.E - summer 1: Sikhism**

We will begin by looking at what Sikhs believe and how it compares to Christianity. We will then look at the history, leaders and festivals that Sikhs celebrate.

**Summer 2: Understanding faith**

In the second half-term we will be looking at the diversity within religion and how different individuals and communities show their faith and exercise their religion.

**ART and DT:**

This term we will be learning about Peter Carl Faberge and his famous Faberge Eggs. After researching a range of different designs, we will begin to sketch out our own designs and create our own Faberge eggs.

**COMPUTING** - This term we are extremely lucky to take part in Design Club. We will be researching, planning, creating and testing our own user friendly apps.
