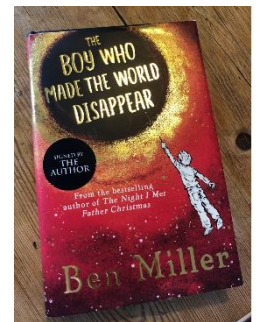
Dearest 2W.
