Dear Parents/Carers

The Football Training for Girls in Year 3 and 4 will be recommencing on **Thursday, 29th April at 3.30pm**. It will run every Thursday, 3.30 - 4.30pm during the Summer Term until (and including) **Thursday, 8th July 2021**.

This is a club for children of all abilities to enjoy and it will be run by Ms Goldberg. There are only 10 places which will be allocated on a first come first served basis.

The club runs from 3.30pm - 4.30pm and children will change into their sportswear at the end of the school day. We kindly ask that you provide your child with a bottle of water. Children will be dismissed from the back gate, at the end of the club.

The booking facility will be open from 6.00pm on **Monday, 15th March**. The closing date for registration is 6.00pm on **Monday 22nd March** but popular clubs are likely to fill up before then.

The cost of the club for this term is £25. Please do not send in any money at this stage. If your child is allocated a place we will notify you and you should make full payment by return otherwise we will offer the place to the next child on the waiting list. We do expect children to stick to clubs; therefore, this subscription fee is non-refundable.

Extended school activities are run for the benefit and enjoyment of all children, therefore, any child who regularly does not comply with the teacher will be asked to leave the club.

In the event of regular non-attendance, the place may be given to someone else. If all the spaces have been allocated, your child will be put on a waiting list for the Summer Term. Please remember, this will not give your child priority for the following term.

In line with government guidance, we are prioritising outside sports clubs this term and have completed a risk assessment to ensure that we continue to protect our school community. In the event of staff sickness, or bubbles and staff members self-isolating, we may have to cancel the club on the day via text message. We will, of course, refund you the money owed.
