Dear Parents and Carers,

COVID-19 update

Thankfully, we are yet to have any positive cases of Covid-19 amongst children or staff in school. However, please do remain vigilant of the symptoms of Covid-19 (a high temperature of 38 degrees Celsius or above; a loss or change to their sense of smell or taste; a new and continuous cough). If your child develops **one or more** of these symptoms, please take them for a PCR test and inform school as soon as possible. Should we have a positive case in school, I will inform parents in that class and advise children are taken for a PCR test. They can continue to attend school as long as they don't test positive or have any symptoms.

As a school, we continue to minimise the spread of Covid-19 by ensuring there is good hand hygiene, encouraging 'catch it, bin it, kill it' for coughs and sneezes, there is regular cleaning and rooms are well-ventilated.
